This letter responds to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request assigned Naval Special Warfare Command (NAVSPECWARCOM) number 16-185. Specifically, you are requesting record showing if Shaun Robert Williams ever participated in Navy Sea Air Land (SEAL) training and/or qualified as a U.S. Navy SEAL. You provided spelling of full name and date of birth.

Pursuant to procedures established in Secretary of the Navy Instruction (SECNAVINST) 5720.42F, our search for responsive records encompassed only those in still in existence as of May 18, 2016 the date your request was received.

Our search included records maintained in our student database, this command's central repository for SEAL candidate training and graduation records located at the Naval Special Warfare Center. However, despite this diligent search, which included variations in spelling and order of name, we were unable to locate documents indicating Shaun Robert Williams ever qualified as a U.S. Navy SEAL or ever participated in U.S. Navy SEAL training.

We recommend you consider making a request to the Navy Personnel Command (NPC), who may be authorized to provide you some information concerning the U.S. Navy service of the individual who is the subject of your inquiry. NPC contact information is:


If you believe an adequate search for responsive records was not accomplished, you may consider this an adverse determination of your request that may be appealed in writing to:
